ESSER III Use of Funds Plan



The following items will be funded with ESSER III monies to specifically address learning loss.

- Part time Title I Teacher working with at risk students addressing learning loss and supporting the evidenced based strategies classrooms teachers are utilizing for three years
- Three years of after-school tutoring, 4 tutors for 180 days
- Four years of summer school credit recovery, 2 tutors for 4 weeks

Other items funded with ESSER III funds.

- COVID Pay: Pay to recognize the additional time and effort employees spend outside of normal working hours and the additional costs they have incurred, or experienced, in order to provide and maintain the continuity of learning during the COVID-19 pandemic, ensuring as little disruption as possible occurs
- Savvas 6-12 science digital licenses curriculum/textbooks to address learning loss due to the COVID 19 pandemic for two years
- Behavior Advocate, funded for two years. Focusing on student behaviors that could impede a student's ability to receive classroom instruction. In one-on-one and small-group settings, deliver appropriate, collaboratively designed behavior interventions. Monitor progress to determine effectiveness of intervention strategies employed
- Sanitation and PPE Supplies: Sneeze guards/desk dividers, hand sanitizer dispensers & refills, soap dispensers & refills, automatic sink faucets, automatic paper towel dispensers, thermometers, face masks, face shields, portable hand washing stations, water bottle fill stations, sanitizing wipes, air purifiers & foggers, etc
- Additional contracted cleaning services for sanitation of building
- Family engagement and educational TV, radio and digital media ads promoting the importance of education, attending school, and family engagement in their children's education
- Physical Education Teacher for two years
